Invitation to Review Configurable Items amended for the February 2010 BSC Systems Release (CP1301, CP1313 and CP1314)

What is the purpose of this Circular?

This Circular invites you to review the Configurable Items that are being amended for the February 2010 Release as a result of the following Change Proposals (CPs):

- [CP1301](#) 'Registration Requirements for System Connection Points Between Onshore Distribution Systems and Offshore Transmission Systems';
- [CP1313](#) 'Remove ELEXON from the Minimum Eligible Amount (MEA) request process'; and
- [CP1314](#) 'Housekeeping change to SAA Service Description'.

CP1301 was approved by the Imbalance Settlement Group (ISG) in August 2009 and CP1313 and CP1314 were approved by the ISG in October 2009.
