### **Invitation to review Configurable Items amended as part of the November 2010 BSC Systems Release (P243/P244)**

#### **What is the purpose of this circular?**

We invite you to review the following Configurable Items (CIs) amended for Modifications P243 'Publication of Generator Forward Availability by Fuel Type' and P244 'Provision of BritNed flow data to the BMRS' as part of the November 2010 BSC Systems Release.

We've published these on our [website](#) for you to review and provide your comments. The documents will go live on 4 November 2010.

#### **What do these changes aim to achieve?**

P243 aims to produce a more detailed forecast of Generator availability, by publishing Output Usable data, broken down by 'fuel types' on the BMRS. It also means Generation Data and Generating Plant Demand Data will no longer be published on the ELEXON website; these will now only be available on the BMRS.

P244 adds an additional fuel category to the BMRS to accommodate the upcoming England-Netherlands Interconnector (BritNed). P244 also allows for future Interconnector data to be incorporated into the BMRS without the need for a Modification Proposal.

#### **Are there any related changes coming up?**

We also anticipate that Change Proposal 1333 ([CP1333](#)) 'Improved Reporting of Prices for SO-SO trades' will be approved in June for implementation in the November 10 BSC Systems Release. CP1333 will impact the Word versions of both IDD Part 1 and IDD Part 2 only. However as this is a CP, the redlined IDD

amendments will have been sent out via [CPC00680](#) as part of the CP's Impact Assessment. If approved, we'll incorporate these amendments into the final IDD version along with the P243 and P244 changes.

CP1333 proposes to change the BMRS to present System Operator (SO)-SO price data in a more structured manner allowing Parties to locate it easily should the volume of trade data increase significantly.

### **How will these changes impact me?**

For these changes, the Balancing Mechanism Reporting Service (BMRS) will publish data via new and amended Tibco messages.
