BSCP201 'Black Start and Fuel Security Contingency Provisions and Claims Processes' (new BSCP) industry review

What is the purpose of this Circular?

This Circular invites you to review the CSDs that have been developed or are being amended for the November 2009 Release as a result of the following Modifications:

- Approved Modification P231 'Black Start and Fuel Security Market Recovery Processes'
- Approved Modification P232 'Black start and Fuel Security Contingency Provisions and Single Imbalance Price Derivation'

P231 and P232 were approved by the Authority in June 2009 with an implementation date of 5 November 2009.

What documents are impacted?

BSCP201 'Black Start and Fuel Security Contingency Provisions and Claims Processes' is a new CSD developed as a result of P231 and P232. It contains procedures regarding:

- Market recovery to normal operating conditions as a result of a Black Start;
- Approving and applying the single imbalance price methodology; and
- Submitting and determining any claims for compensation from Black Start periods or Fuel Security Code events.

There are minor impacts to BSCP18 'Corrections to Bid-Offer Acceptance Related Data' and the ECVAA Service Description.

The changes to BSCP18 are on top of changes already approved as part of P217 which is also to be implemented as part of the November 09 Release. The approved P217 changes were baselined on live version 3.0, and approved by the ISG102 on 28 July 2009 at version 0.4. The BSCP18 extract is version 0.5 based on the live version 3.0.
