OPEN SESSION – DECISION PAPERS

1. Market Index Definition Statement Review 2018 – ISG209/04

The Market Index Definition Statement (MIDS) was reviewed for 2018. A four week Industry Consultation was proposed.

2. Non-Standard BMU Applications: RWE – Cheshire Power Station – ISG209/05

RWE Generation UK Plc applied for two non-standard BMUs: one for its Cheshire East and one for its Cheshire West Generating Units.
