Synopsis This report sets out the headlines and key decisions taken at the most recent PAB meeting.

Part I: Confidential Session – Decision

1. BSC Party Error and Failure Resolution (EFR) Escalation for Non-Half Hourly (NHH) Settlement Performance (PAB274/04)

- 1.1 Elexon invited the PAB to note BSC Party's update, approve new milestones; and additional follow-up actions in regards to the escalation.
- 1.2 The PAB:
 - a) NOTED BSC Party's update;
 - b) **DETERMINED** additional follow-up actions in regards to the escalation.
 - c) **REJECTED** new milestones; and

2. Risk Report (PAB274/05)

- 2.1 This paper provided:
 - An overview of Market level performance in each market segment;
 - An update on Risks that are of current concern;
 - CVA Risk Updates; and
 - Performance Assurance Technique Updates.
- 2.2 The PAB:
 - a) **NOTED** the contents of the Quarterly Performance Thresholds Review;
 - b) **AGREED** to maintain the threshold applied for the focus Suppliers in the NHH and MC F market at 1,250MWh and a corresponding 625MWh EFR exit criteria;
 - c) AGREED to maintain the threshold applied for the focus Suppliers in the HH MC C and non-domestic sub 100kW (MCs E and G) markets at 850MWh and a corresponding 425MWh EFR exit criteria;
 - d) AGREED to set the threshold applied for the focus Suppliers in the NHH Export market at 1,250MWh and a corresponding 625MWh EFR exit criteria;
 - e) NOTED the likely changes to the thresholds at the next review but did not agree they should be changed;
 - f) NOTED the Market Performance Update;

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- g) NOTED the Supplier Performance Update;
- h) NOTED the Risks of Current Concern update;
- i) NOTED the CVA Risk Update;
- j) NOTED the Performance Assurance Techniques update;
- k) AGREED that EFR should be turned on for a BSC Party for consistently breaching its Large EAC/AA Materiality Threshold, and a letter is written to confirm this;
- I) **AGREED** that EFR should be turned on for a BSC Party in relation to Non Half Hourly Measurement Class A and Half Hourly Measurement Class F performance and a letter is written to confirm this;
- m) **AGREED** that EFR should be turned on for a BSC Party in relation to Non Half Hourly Measurement Class A Export performance and a letter is written to confirm this;
 - n) **AGREED** that EFR should be turned on for a BSC Party in relation to Non Half Hourly Measurement Class A Export performance and a letter is written to confirm this; and
 - o) AGREED that EFR should be turned off for a BSC Party in relation to Half Hourly Measurement Class C performance and a letter is written to confirm this.

3. Qualification Report for October 2023 (PAB274/03)

- 3.1 Elexon invited the PAB to Qualify a Qualification application for November 2023.
- 3.2 The PAB:
 - a) **APPROVED** a BSC Party's application for Qualification for the role of Asset Metering Virtual Lead Party (AMVLP); and
 - b) **DETERMINED** that the BSC Party complete a Disaster Recovery plan within six months of go-live and provide supporting evidence to Elexon when completed.

4. Market Wide Half Hourly Settlement (MHHS) Assurance Consequential Code Changes

4.1 Elexon provided a verbal update on the code changes that will be proposed for endorsement by the PAB as its December 2023 meeting.

5. Supplier Charges (PAB274/07)

- 5.1 Elexon invited the PAB to approve the Supplier Charges for the August 2023 reporting period.
- 5.2 The PAB:
 - a) APPROVED the net positions set out in the Payment Instructions for August 2023 (Attachment A); and
 - b) **AUTHORISED** that the Supplier Charges Reports for August 2023 are published, which Elexon will send to Trading Parties.
