## DECISION PAPERS

### 1.      **Trading Dispute DA1067 – TDC270/01**

1.1      Elexon raising Trading Dispute DA1067 following the identification of a Technical Assurance Agent (TAA) Category 1 non-compliance. Elexon considers Trading Dispute DA1067 invalid as a Settlement Error has not occurred.

The TDC:

- a) **AGREED** that the Trading Dispute was raised in accordance with the Dispute Deadline;
- b) **AGREED** that the materiality does not exceed £3,000;
- c) **AGREED** that a Settlement Error has not occurred;
- d) **REJECTED** the Trading Dispute; and
- e) **AGREED** no rectification is required.

### 2.      **Trading Dispute DA1071 – TDC270/02**

2.1      Trading Dispute DA1071 was raised by Elexon following the identification of a Technical Assurance Agent (TAA) non-compliance. Estimated data was entered into Settlement for a supply that had been disconnected, causing a Settlement Error.

The TDC:

- a) **AGREED** the end date of 17 December 2019;
- b) **AGREED** that the Trading Dispute was raised in accordance with the Dispute Deadline;
- c) **AGREED** that the materiality exceeds £3,000;
- d) **AGREED** that a Settlement Error has occurred;
- e) **UPHELD** the Trading Dispute; and
- f) **AGREED** means of rectification through the normal and Post-Final Settlement Runs.

### 3. Trading Dispute DA1105 – TDC270/03

Zero volumes were entered into Settlement as a result of a Meter fault, causing a Settlement Error.

The TDC:

- a) **AGREED** the end date of 2 September 2019;
- b) **AGREED** that the Trading Dispute was raised in accordance with the Dispute Deadline;
- c) **DETERMINED** to exercise discretion under Section W of the Code and grant exceptional circumstances;
- d) **AGREED** that the materiality exceeds £3,000;
- e) **AGREED** that a Settlement Error has occurred;
- f) **UPHELD** the Trading Dispute; and
- g) **AGREED** means of rectification through the Post-Final Settlement Run.

### 4. Trading Dispute DA1109 – TDC270/04

Elxon has raised Trading Dispute DA1109 following the identification of a Technical Assurance Agent (TAA) Category 1 non-compliance. Elxon considers Trading Dispute DA1067 invalid as there is no material impact on Settlement.

The TDC:

- a) **AGREED** that the Trading Dispute was raised in accordance with the Dispute Deadline;
- b) **AGREED** that the materiality does not exceed £3,000;
- c) **AGREED** that a Settlement Error has occurred;
- d) **REJECTED** the Trading Dispute; and
- e) **AGREED** no rectification is required.

### 5. Trading Dispute DA1097 – TDC270/05

A Phase failure meant that erroneous zero values were entered into Settlement.

The TDC:

- a) **AGREED** the end date of 1 April 2019;
- b) **AGREED** that the Trading Dispute was raised in accordance with the Dispute Deadline;
- c) **DETERMINED** to exercise discretion under Section W of the Code and grant exceptional circumstances;
- d) **AGREED** that the materiality exceeds £3,000;
- e) **AGREED** that a Settlement Error has occurred;
- f) **UPHELD** the Trading Dispute; and
- g) **AGREED** means of rectification through the Post-Final Settlement Run.

### 6. Trading Dispute DA1101 – TDC270/06

Usage from a De-Energised meter has been incorrectly attributed to a Meter causing erroneous zero values to be entered into Settlement

The TDC:

- a) **AGREED** the end date of 24 July 2019;
- b) **AGREED** that the Trading Dispute was raised in accordance with the Dispute Deadline;
- c) **DETERMINED** to exercise discretion under Section W of the Code and grant exceptional circumstances;

- d) **AGREED** that the materiality exceeds £3,000;
- e) **AGREED** that a Settlement Error has occurred;
- f) **UPHELD** the Trading Dispute; and
- g) **AGREED** means of rectification through the Post-Final Settlement Run.
