OPEN SESSION - DECISION PAPERS

1. MDD Change Requests for Version 308 (SVG241/01)

1.1 This paper invited the SVG to approve 13 General Change Requests, and note 14 Fast Track Change Requests, for implementation in Version 308 of Market Domain Data (MDD) with a go-live date of 17 March 2021.

The SVG:

- a) **APPROVED** 13 General Change Requests for implementation in MDD 308 with a go-live date of 17 March 2021;
- b) **NOTED** 14 Fast Track Change Requests for implementation in MDD 308 with a go-live date of 17 March 2021; and
- c) NOTED the Market Participant Impact Assessment comments for CR M3748 and M3750.

2. LLF Audit Results (SVG241/09)

2.1 This paper reported the results of Elexon's remote annual audit of Line Loss Factor (LLF) values for the 2021/2022 BSC Year, performed in accordance with BSCP128. It invited the SVG to approve the Supplier Volume Allocation (SVA) LLF values for all of the Licensed Distribution System Operators (LDSOs).

The SVG:

- a) NOTED that all SVA non-compliances have been resolved;
- b) APPROVED the SVA LLFs for use in Settlement from 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022; and
- c) NOTED that we will seek the ISG's approval of the CVA LLFs at its meeting on 02 March 2021.

3. UMSUG Updates to the Operational Information Document (OID) (SVG241/05)

3.1 The Unmetered Supplies User Group (UMSUG) recommended a number of changes to the Operational Information Document (OID). The SVG was invited to approve the changes to the OID.

The SVG:

- a) **NOTED** the UMSUG recommended changes to the OID;
- b) APPROVED the changes to the OID; and

c) **NOTED** that, subject to approval, the updated OID will be published on the Elexon website when MDD changes go-live in March 2021.

4. Metering Dispensation D/517 - New Cross Tunnel Boring Machine (SVG241/02)

4.1 Engie Power Ltd applied for a temporary Metering Dispensation (D/517), against Code of Practice (CoP) 4. This is for the Metering Equipment that will measure the supply for the New Cross Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM). CoP4 requires the Calibration Certificates for the current transformers (CTs) and voltage transformers (VTs), produced after 6 November 2008, to have statements of measurement uncertainty on them. The Calibration Certificates for the CTs and VT for the TBM supplies do not have statements of measurement uncertainty on them. The SVG were invited to approve D/517 on a temporary basis until 31 December 2025.

The SVG:

- a) APPROVED Metering Dispensation D/517, on a temporary basis until 31 December 2025, for the VT Calibration Certificate for the New Cross Tunnel Boring Machine supplies not having measurement uncertainty evaluations related to the accuracy test results; and
- b) **NOTED** that we will present a similar decision paper to the Imbalance Settlement Group (ISG) at its meeting on 2 March 2021 and recommend the same revised recommendation above.

5. Metering Dispensation D/516 – Moray East Offshore Wind Farm (SVG241/03)

5.1 Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Ltd applied for a lifetime Metering Dispensation (D/516) against Code of Practice (CoP) 5 to not measure the low voltage supplies to Offshore Transmission Owner (OFTO) assets, through its own auxiliary transformers, on the Offshore platforms, at the Moray East Offshore Wind Farm. The SVG were invited to approve D/516 on a lifetime basis.

The SVG:

a) APPROVED Metering Dispensation D/516, for Moray East Offshore Wind Farm, on a lifetime basis.

6. Approval of P383 BSC Configurable Items for the April 2021 BSC Release (SVG241/04)

6.1 This paper invited the SVG to approve the changes to the P383 BSC Configurable Items to be implemented as part of the April 2021 BSC Release.
