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Purpose of paper Decision

Summary We reviewed the Line Loss Factor (LLF) Methodology Statements submitted by

Licensed Distribution System Owners (LDSOs), in accordance with BSCP128. All methodologies were changed to accommodate the new 'Principle 17'. Subject to approval by the Imbalance Settlement Group (ISG) and Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG), ELEXON will publish the LLF methodologies submitted

by the LDSOs on the ELEXON Portal.

1. Methodology review

- 1.1 In accordance with BSC Section K1.7.7, we performed the annual review of the Line Loss Factor (LLF) methodology statements submitted by each Licensed Distribution System Operator (LDSO). The methodology review follows the procedure set out in BSC Procedure (BSCP) 128 'Production, Submission, Audit and Approval of Line Loss Factors'.
- 1.2 Each year, LDSOs must submit a Methodology Self-Assessment Document (MSAD). This includes a methodology statement which sets out how the LDSO intends to calculate LLFs for the following BSC Year (April to March). We audit these methodology statements to ensure that they are compliant with the 17 principles set out in BSCP128.
- 1.3 In accordance with BSCP128 2.2, where LDSOs operate an embedded network within a distribution area there is an alternative review process. These Embedded LDSOs have to state the areas in which they will operate. They do not need a methodology if they Mirror the Host LDSO's LLFs for the relevant area.

2. Changes to methodology statements

- 2.1 This year's methodologies will apply to LLFs calculated for the 2019/20 BSC Year.
- 2.2 We have received and completed reviews of all methodologies and MSADs and are satisfied that they are compliant with BSC Section K1.7.7 (a) and (b).
- 2.3 LDSOs have amended their existing approved methodology statements from 2018/19 to accommodate the new Principle 17 'Where the usage profile for a given site contains insufficiently large consumption or generation volumes to enable calculation of realistic Site Specific LLFs then a default calculation, or default replacement process shall be undertaken.'
- 2.4 All of the Embedded LDSOs will mirror the Host LDSO methodologies.
- 2.5 The table below summarises the changes to the methodology statements and where the methodology has changed from last year:

3. Next steps

- 3.1 The methodologies require approval from both the ISG and SVG. The ISG approved them at its meeting on 21 August 2018. Once approved, we will publish the methodologies on the ELEXON Portal. All draft methodology statements are available to Committee members on request.
- 3.2 The next milestone for the LLF audit is 30 September 2018, by which time all Host LDSOs must submit their LLF values for the 2019/20 BSC Year, followed by the LLF calculation audit starting in October 2018. We will perform Host LDSOs audits' on site, except for Scottish Power (SPOW) who will have a remote audit.
- Once the calculation audit is complete for both Host and Embedded LDSOs, we will ask the ISG (February 2019) and the SVG (March 2019) to approve the final LLF values which will go live on 1 April 2019.



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4. Recommendations

- 4.1 We invite you to:
 - a) **APPROVE** the six Host LDSOs' methodologies, noting the changes made to all six from last year;
 - b) NOTE all Embedded LDSOs' intention to Mirror the Host LDSOs' LLFs; and
 - c) **NOTE** that the ISG approved the Host LDSO methodologies at its 21 August 2018 meeting.

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
