# CP to allow the online management of registrations, Market Entry and Market Exit

### What's the Issue?

- The current process for Market Entry, Market Exit, BM Unit registration and Authorised Signatories are based on the paper forms developed at NETA go live
- This requires the same information to be populated over multiple forms
- Process can be seen as inefficient and can be simplified and streamlined
- The CSDs are restrictive to communication methods being used



# What is the Foundation Programme?

- Foundation Programme is developing 'self service' Participant Management System
- Developed using a customised version of Salesforce referred to as a 'Self-Service Gateway'
- CRA will be moved to Salesforce allowing self-service and futureproofing Central Registration Systems
- Will provide online platform and digitised process for:
  - Market Entry
  - Market Exit
  - -BM Unit registration
  - -Authorised Signatories



# **Changes required to the BSC**

- The CSDs describe the processes and prescribe the methods of communication that can be used
- Paper forms will still be available to use, but this CP will include the new Self-Service Gateway as an approved submission method in the CSDs



### **Impacts and Costs**

#### Impacts

 12 CSDs will need updating to allow the Self Service Gateway to used for submissions

### Costs

-£2060 to implement the necessary document changes

 No mandatory impacts for participants as CP will just enable use of Self-Service Gateway, but paper forms will still be valid



# **Progression and Implementation**

### Progression

- Include in next CPC batch on 8 October
- CP Assessment Report for Decision at ISG on 20 November and SVG on 4 December

### Implementation

- Self-Service Gateway is being implemented under ELEXON's Foundation
  Programme
  - -This CP enables the new system to be used for data submissions
- Proposed Implementation Date of 28 February 2019
  - In line with the Foundation Programme Release 1 and P344 ' Implementation of Project TERRE into the GB arrangements'
