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Purpose of paper Decision

Summary This paper invites the Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG) to approve 11

General Change Requests, and note 12 Fast Track Change Requests, for implementation in Version 282 of Market Domain Data (MDD) with a go-live

date of 17 April 2019.

1. Introduction

1.1. Updates to Market Domain Data (MDD) are made through monthly releases. ELEXON progresses MDD changes in accordance with <u>BSC Procedure (BSCP) 509 'Changes to Market Domain Data'</u>.

General Change Request process

1.2. BSCP509 requires that General MDD Change Requests undergo validation by ELEXON, and impact assessment by the Supplier Volume Allocation Agent (SVAA) and Market Participants, before we present them to the SVG for decision. Unmetered Supplies (UMS) Charge Codes are initially reviewed by the UMS User Group (UMSUG) in accordance with <u>BSCP520 'Unmetered Supplies'</u>, and also go out for Market Participant impact assessment before coming to the SVG. We collate all comments received through the impact assessment and include them in this paper to assist the SVG in making a decision on each change.

Fast Track Change Request process

- 1.3. BSCP509 contains a Fast Track process for housekeeping changes and new participant registrations. These still undergo ELEXON validation and SVAA impact assessment. However, BSCP509 does not require Fast Track changes to be issued for Market Participant impact assessment or to be approved by the SVG. This means that they can be submitted later in the monthly process than General Change Requests, and that we present them to the SVG for information rather than approval.
- 1.4. New Party Agents and existing Licensed Distribution System Operators (LDSOs) registering in a GSP Group must have their Qualification approved by the Performance Assurance Board (PAB) before registering in MDD. However, they can submit their Fast Track Change Request before the PAB meeting for the next MDD version to go live after the PAB's decision. Should the PAB not approve the Qualification application, ELEXON will refuse the MDD Change Request. New Suppliers and new LDSOs do not require PAB approval of their Qualification before registering in MDD, and new Suppliers need not have obtained their Supply Licence.

2. This month's changes

2.1 This paper includes 11 General MDD changes and 12 Fast Track MDD changes to be incorporated into MDD version 282 with a go-live date of 17 April 2019.

Market Participant Impact Assessment comments on General Change Requests

2.3 During the impact assessment, a Market Participant raised a comment that the MPIA Circular indicated that new LLFCs are being created against M3300, M3303, and M3307, but did not have an Entity 17 LLFC Form attached. This was an error in the MPIA Circular – no new LLFCs were being created, just new Valid NHH Combinations against existing LLFCs. The Market Participant was satisfied with our response to this effect.

3. Line Loss Factor validations

3.1 There are two Change Requests for MDD 282, which requests the opening of new LLF Classes (LLFCs) to be effective from 17 April 2019. The relevant LDSOs have submitted their D0265 files ('Line Loss Factor Data Files') for their Mid-Year Submissions. The following table provides further details.

3.2 ELEXON has validated the D0265 files to ensure that the structure of the files and the submitted LLF values comply with the audit scope of Section 3.5 of <u>BSCP128 'Production, Submission, Audit and Approval of Line Loss Factors'</u>. The submitted D0265 files have passed validation.

4. Extra MDD Version 281

- 4.1 The SVG approved MDD Version 280 at its meeting on 05 March 2019, which was published on 14 March 2019 with a go-live date of 20 March 2019. This version contained a file error due to the inclusion of two erroneous GSP Group Ids in the Average Fraction of Yearly Consumption (AFYC) Set), which affected the successful loading of this file for some Participants. Full details were communicated to Participants in MDD Circular MDD00659.
- 4.2 To resolve this, we published an additional Version 281 on 18 March 2019 with a go-live date of 20 March 2019. Therefore this month's regular MDD release has incremented to Version 282. An updated MDD Release schedule was also published.

5. Recommendations

- 5.1 ELEXON invites the SVG to:
 - a) **APPROVE** the 11 General Change Requests for implementation in MDD 282 with a go-live date of 17 April 2019;
 - b) **NOTE** the 12 Fast Track Change Requests for implementation in MDD 282 with a go-live date of 17 April 2019; and
 - c) **APPROVE** the proposed LLFCs for two LDSOs for use in Settlement from 17 April 2019.
