COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE PANEL

There were no recommendations to the Panel.

OPEN SESSION

1. MDD Change Requests For Version 291 – (226/01)

This paper invited the Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG) to approve two General Change Requests, and note 13 Fast Track Change Requests, for implementation in Version 291 of Market Domain Data (MDD) with a go-live date of 18 December 2019.

The SVG:

- APPROVED** the two General Change Requests for implementation in MDD 291 with a go-live date of 18 December 2019; and
- NOTED** the 13 Fast Track Change Requests for implementation in MDD 291 with a go-live date of 18 December 2019.

2. Allocating Richborough (RICH_J) GSP to the South Eastern (_J) GSP Group – (226/02)

The National Electricity Transmission System Operator (NETSO) has registered a new Grid Supply Point (GSP) at Richborough. The SVG, under delegated authority from the BSC Panel, must allocate this new GSP to a GSP Group. ELEXON recommended that the SVG allocates this GSP to the South Eastern _J GSP Group.

The SVG:

- APPROVED** the allocation of GSP RICH_J to the South Eastern (_J) GSP Group.

3. CP1521 'BSCP70 Amendments for Interconnector Administrators and Interconnector Error Administrators' – (226/03)

- 3.1 This document is the Change Proposal (CP) Assessment Report for CP1521, which ELEXON presented to the Imbalance Settlement Group (ISG) at its meeting on 19 November 2019 and to the Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG) on 3 December 2019. The Committees considered the proposed solution and the responses received to the CP Consultation before making a decision on whether to approve CP1521.

- 3.2 The SVG:

- APPROVED** the proposed changes to BSCP70 for CP1521; and
- APPROVED** CP1521 for implementation on 27 February 2020 as part of the February 2020 Release.

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c) **NOTED** that CP1521 was presented for decision to the:

- ISG on 19 Nov 2019; and
- SVG on 3 Dec 2019.

4. Annual AFYC recalculation and review – (226/04)

4.1 This paper recommended that the Profiling Expert Group (PEG) acts as a review group for this year's Average Fraction of Yearly Consumption (AFYC) recalculation. It invited the SVG to agree this, along with the proposed timetable and calculation period.

4.2 The SVG:

- a) **AGREED** that the PEG acts as the AFYC Review Group;
- b) **AGREED** the proposed timetable; and
- c) **AGREED** the calculation period of 1 November 2018 to 31 October 2019.
