Title (mandatory by originator)

Adding P-flows and a testing request process to the VLP Market Entry Process

Description of Problem/Issue (mandatory by originator)

A new Qualification Testing Service (QTS) is available for <u>Virtual Lead Parties</u> (VLPs). However, BSCP70 'CVA Qualification Testing for Parties and Party Agents' and the Communication Requirements Document (CRD) does not include the P-flows that need to be tested by VLPs. Further, there is no documented process for VLPs requesting to book in for testing.

The missing test request process and P-flows in BSCP70 and the CRD creates inefficiencies in the Central Volume Allocation (CVA) testing exercise for VLPs during the Market Entry process.

Proposed Solution (mandatory by originator)

This Change proposal seeks to:

- Include a list of all P-Flows that needs to be tested by VLPs in <u>BSCP70</u> and the <u>Communication</u> <u>Requirements Document (CRD);</u>
- Include a new process in BSCP70 document that enables VLPs to request the use of the QTS for the purpose of testing P-Flows; and
- Clarify which P-flows will need to be sent as a sample file to ensure its structure can be validated against the system

Justification for Change (mandatory by originator)

This change will enable VLPs to more easily complete the requirement of the CVA Qualification Testing on all relevant P-flows. It will also make the BSCP70 a single point of reference for VLPs who request to test all relevant P-flows during the Market Entry process.

This improves the CVA testing experience for VLPs. It also removes the risk of VLPs not testing all P-flows during the Market entry process, and as a result, could cause a delay on their application.
