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The National Electricity Transmission System Operator (NETSO) has registered a new Grid Supply Point (GSP) at Wesley Avenue. The SVG, under delegated authority from the BSC Panel, must allocate this new GSP to a GSP Group. Elexon recommends that the SVG allocates this GSP to the Southern _H GSP Group.

1. Why have we brought this matter to the SVG?

- 1.1 The NETSO has registered a new GSP. The SVG, under delegated authority from the BSC Panel, must allocate a new GSP to a GSP Group in accordance with BSC Section K1.8 and BSC Procedure (BSCP) 25.
- 1.2 Southern Electric Power Distribution (SEPD) is connecting two new circuits at Wesley Avenue in the Willesden 66 kV substation. This new Systems Connection Point will be registered in Settlement as a new GSP, to be known as Wesley Avenue - Willesden GSP (WESA H).
- 1.3 The National Electricity Transmission System Operator (NETSO) propose that GSP WESA_H is allocated to the Southern (_H) GSP Group.

The case for approving this allocation 2.

- The SVG should consider the following when allocating GSPs to GSP Groups (BSC K1.8.3-K1.8.4): 2.1
- The effect of geographical factors in establishing Daily Profile Coefficients;
- The effect of the size of the GSP Group on GSP Group Correction Factors;
- The effect of the proximity (in terms of electrical connection) of the Boundary Points on the value to the NETSO (in the operation of the NETSO) of Supplier BM Unit Physical Notifications and Bid-Offer Pairs; and
- The views of impacted parties (Ofgem, the NETSO, impacted Licenced Distribution System Operators (LDSOs) and all Suppliers).
- The NETSO and SEPD have stated that the new GSP WESA _H should be allocated to the Southern (_H) 2.2 GSP Group because the System Connection Points will be connected to the Southern Electric Power Distribution (SEPD) Distribution System.
- 2.3 We issued a two-week industry consultation on 7 March 2022 so that Suppliers and other relevant parties could submit their views.
- 2.4 No comments on this Consultation were received. This is not a cause for concern as the NETSO and SEPD agreed to the GSP Group allocation prior to the consultation and the new GSP is connected to the Southern Electric Power Distribution (SEPD) Distribution System.

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3. Recommendations

- 3.1 We invite the SVG to:
 - a) **APPROVE** the allocation of GSP WESA_H to the Southern (_H) GSP Group.

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
