# **Open Session – Information Papers**

- 1. Protocol Approval Stark Software International Limited (SSIL) for the Landis + Gyr ZMD/ZFD Meter types (SVG260/03)
- 1.1 Elexon invited the SVG members to note that, following successful protocol testing, we have issued Stark Software International Limited (SSIL) with a Certificate of Protocol Approval. The certificate covers approval of

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the protocol for the Landis + Gyr ZMD/ZFD Meter types, embedded within Stark's Reality data collection software.

- 1.2 The SVG Committee had no comments
- 1.3 The SVG:
  - a) **NOTED** that Elexon issued a Certificate of Protocol Approval to Stark Software International (SSIL), an Half Hourly Data Collector (HHDC), for the Landis + Gyr ZMD/ZFD Meter types;
  - b) **NOTED** that Elexon updated the 'CoP Compliance and Protocol Approval' list for the protocol approval for the Landis + Gyr ZMD/ZFD Meter types, using SSIL as an HHDC; and
  - c) **NOTED** that Elexon issue a Newscast article notifying BSC Parties and BSC Party Agents of the protocol approval for the Landis + Gyr ZMD/ZFD Meter types, using SSIL as an HHDC.

#### 2. MDD Change Request 328 (SVG260/01)

- 2.1 This paper invited the SVG to approve six General Change Requests and note 16 Fast Track Change Requests, for implementation in Version 328 of Market Domain Data (MDD) with a go-live date of 19 October 2022.
- 2.2 The SVG Committee had no comments
- 2.3 The SVG:
  - a) **APPROVED** six General BAU Change Requests for implementation in MDD 328 with a go-live date of 19 October 2022; and
  - b) **NOTED** 16 Fast Track Change Requests for implementation in MDD 328 with a go-live date of 19 October 2022.

# 3. Dissolution of PEG and impact on AFYC Recalculation process (SVG260/02)

- 3.1 This paper invited the SVG to recommend that the Profiling Expert Group (PEG) is dissolved, and that Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) within Elexon act as a Review Group for future Profiling related tasks, including recalculation of the Average Fraction of Yearly Consumption (AFYC). It invited the SVG to approve this, along with the proposed AFYC timetable and calculation period.
- 3.2 Elexon to take next steps to dissolve the PEG committee, A SVG Member requested that an update be provided in Newscast. Elexon confirmed that it will be shared via Newscast.
- 3.3 The SVG:
  - a) **AGREED** to dissolve the PEG, and allow Elexon SMEs to act as the Review Group and to make recommendations directly to the SVG;
  - b) AGREED to using data from period 1 November 2021 to 31 October 2022 in recalculation of AFYC, GGPCAEAC and GGPCDEAC values; and
  - c) AGREED to the proposed AFYC timetable shown in the paper.
