

**Redlined BSCP11 for CP1459 ‘Amendments to the process for performing a Post-Final Settlement Run whereby Trading Dispute determinations are actioned’**

This CP proposes changes to BSCP11 section 5.4

We have redlined these changes against Version 13.0.

Amend section 5.4 'Performing a Post-Final Settlement Run' as follows:

<sup>17</sup> Each BSC Party shall take or procure its agents including but not limited to Data Collectors and Data Aggregators to take such steps as are necessary to give effect to a determination of the TDC.

<sup>18</sup> A BSC Party may decide to provide its agent(s) with the BSCP11/07 form as provided by the DS in 5.4.2.

<sup>19</sup> Each BSC Agent and each Party shall take or procure its Agents including but not limited to DA and DC to take such steps as are necessary to give effect to a determination of the TDC.

<sup>20</sup> CDCA, SAA, SVAA, FAA and where applicable the CRA, ECVA, Transmission Company and/or and Interconnector Administrators.
