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### About This Document

This document provides information on new Change Proposal (CP) CP1477 and outlines our proposed progression timetable for this change, including when we will issue it for CP Consultation in the next suitable Change Proposal Circular (CPC) batch.

We are presenting this paper to capture any comments or questions on this CP from the Performance Assurance Board (PAB), the Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG) and the Imbalance Settlement Group (ISG) Members, before we issue it for consultation.

We are presenting this paper to multiple committees because they jointly own the impacted Balancing and Settlement Code Procedure (BSCP). Further detail around each committee's ownership of this BSCP is covered in the 'Proposed redlining' section of this document, under section 2 'Solution'.

There are three parts to this document:

- This is the main document. It provides a summary of the solution, impacts, anticipated costs, and proposed implementation approach, as well as our proposed progression approach for this CP.
- Attachment A contains the CP1477 proposal form.
- Attachment B contains the proposed redlined changes to deliver the CP1477 solution.

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# 1 Why Change?

## Background

### Modification P283

Modification [P283 'Reinforcing the Commissioning of Metering Equipment Processes'](#) was implemented on 6 November 2014. The Modification placed commissioning obligations on the Metering Equipment owner, if they are a Balancing and Settlement Code (BSC) Party. This shifted the responsibility for commissioning of measurement transformers from the Meter Operator Agent (MOA) to the Licenced Distribution System Operator (LDSO) (or Transmission Company where applicable). It also placed an obligation on the MOA to inform the Registrant of the commissioning status of each Metering System.

Under P283, MOAs retain responsibility for assessing the overall accuracy of the Metering System. Introducing an obligation for the MOA to communicate the commissioning status of a Metering System to the Registrant (typically the Supplier), was intended to ensure that the Supplier had a complete picture of the status of its Half Hourly (HH) portfolio. The Supplier could then take corrective action over any gaps in the commissioning process.

### Qualification process

As part of the Qualification process, participants applying to Qualify as a Supplier Volume Allocation (SVA) Party, SVA Party Agent or Central Volume Allocation (CVA) MOA must complete [BSCP537 'Appendix 1 Self Assessment Document \(SAD\)'](#). The BSCP537 Appendix 1 is a long Microsoft Word format questionnaire where applicants provide responses and supporting evidence to questions. BSCP537 Appendix 1 provides assurance that the applicant has the necessary systems, processes and knowledge in place to perform in their intended role.

### What is the issue?

BSCP537 Appendix 1 has not been updated since the implementation of P283. Therefore, BSCP537 Appendix 1 does not reflect the new commissioning obligations P283 introduced. ELEXON took an action from [PAB179](#) to investigate if BSCP537 Appendix 1 could be updated in light of P283.

### Proposed solution

ELEXON raised [CP1477 'Updates to BSCP537 Appendix 1 as a result of P283'](#) on 7 November 2016.

This CP proposes to update the questions around the commissioning process in the role specific sections in BSCP537 Appendix 1. If approved CP1477 will update the following sections:

- Question 13.1.8 in Section 13 'SVA HHMOA';
- Question 15.1.6 in Section 15 'CVA MOA'; and
- Question 18.1.5 in Section 18 'Supplier'.

Specifically, this CP will update the guidance on answering questions around the commissioning process. The updated guidance will reflect the new obligations introduced by P283.

This CP also includes some changes to Section 14.1.8 in Section 14 'SVA NHHMOA'. However, these changes are only to add clarity. P283 does not impact SVA Non Half Hourly MOAs (NHHMOAs), so the changes to Section 14.1.8 introduce no new obligations for qualifying SVA NHHMOAs.

### Proposer's rationale

If approved, CP1477 will require applicants to provide evidence that their systems, processes and knowledge meet their P283 commissioning obligations. This will provide assurance that the applicant will meet their commissioning obligations when acting as a Qualified participant.

### Proposed redlining

Attachment B contains the proposed changes to BSCP537 Appendix 1 to deliver CP1477.

We are presenting CP1477 to the PAB, the SVG and the ISG because these committees jointly own BSCP537 Appendix 1 under the BSC Baseline Statement.

The PAB has joint ownership of BSCP537 Appendix 1 because the PAB is responsible for the Qualification Performance Assurance Technique.

The SVG has joint ownership of BSCP537 Appendix 1 because it covers the Qualification of SVA Parties and SVA Party Agents. CP1477 proposes updates to the SVA Half Hourly MOA (HHMOA), SVA NHHMOA and Supplier role specific sections of the BSCP.

The ISG has joint ownership of BSCP537 Appendix 1 as Section 15 'CVA MOA' is for a CVA Party Agent. CP1477 proposes updates to the CVA MOA role specific section of the BSCP.

## 3 Impacts and Costs

### Central impacts and costs

CP1477 will require a change to BSCP537 Appendix 1. No central system changes are required. There will be a small impact on the Qualification Service Provider (QSP). This is because it will have to send a new version of BSCP537 Appendix 1 to qualifying and re-qualifying participants, if the committees approve this change. ELEXON consulted the QSP on this change, and the QSP supported the progression of this change.

The central implementation costs for CP1477 will be approximately £240 (one ELEXON working day) to implement the document changes.

### BSC Party & Party Agent impacts and costs

CP1477 will impact qualifying Suppliers, CVA MOAs and SVA HHMOAs. Applicants qualifying in these roles will have to provide more detailed answers and evidence for questions in BSCP537 Appendix 1 around the commissioning process.

CP1477 will have no impact on Qualified participants, unless they are subject to re-Qualification. Suppliers are not subject to re-Qualification. Therefore, in terms of impacts on Qualified participants, only SVA HHMOAs and CVA MOAs can potentially be affected by CP1477 (if subject to re-Qualification<sup>1</sup>).

SVA HHMOA	More detailed answers and evidence required in BSCP537 Appendix 1 around the commissioning process. Applicable to SVA HHMOAs undergoing Qualification or re-Qualification.

<sup>1</sup> If CP1477 is approved, there is no obligation for Qualified participants to re-Qualify around their commissioning obligations. Re-Qualification is subject to Section 2.2 'Re-Qualification Process' in [BSCP537 'Qualification Process for SVA Parties, SVA Party Agents and CVA MOAs'](#).

## 4 Implementation Approach

### Recommended Implementation Date

We propose to implement CP1477 on **29 June 2017** as part of the June 2017 BSC Systems Release.

We have proposed this Implementation Date as it is the next practical BSC Systems Release that can include CP1477. This Implementation Date also aligns with changes to BSCP537 Appendix 1 as part of [CP1474 'Updating the CoMC processes to facilitate the elective HH Settlement of SMETS Meters'](#). This means the QSP can issue one new version of BSCP537 Appendix 1 to qualifying and re-qualifying participants following the June 2017 BSC Systems Release.
